The Literacy Assistance Center offers a results-oriented six-month certificate program in Leadership Development for Emerging Leaders that combines skill-building workshops with one-on-one leadership coaching.

Who should participate?

New and first-level program managers stepping up to positions where they play a major role in developing or implementing organizational objectives.

What you will learn

Participating program managers work with Leadership Coaches to identify the most significant challenges they face and identify appropriate goals. Then they develop an action plan to meet those goals. Emerging leaders strengthen their ability to meet critical challenges in the field.
